Formation of Student Chapters

Benefits of Joining

- Stipend allotted to school to host events
- Each student gets access to student member rates for all of SEAoNY and NCSEA professional seminars
- Each student gets a Cross Sections and Structure Magazine Subscription
- Students may be directly involved in committee meetings
- Student input for new events

Formation of Student Chapters

How to Start a Chapter:

- An executive board needs to be formed
- Chapter Bylaws need to be submitted for approval by the committee
- Students can register with the chapter at any time after formation

Student Requirements:

- To be a chapter member, students must register with national (NCSEA) for a fee of \$25.
- Non-members can still participate in events but do not get all of the member benefits
